Property Rights Australia (PRA) remains deeply concerned regarding the State's zealotry as it implements wind, solar and pumped hydro projects and critically, interconnecting high voltage transmission lines across Queensland.

"Landowners are sick and tired of token consultation process, a lack of empathy from the State government regarding the social and economic value of the land and the undermining of confidence across regional communities," Chair of Property Rights Australia (PRA) Rob Atkinson said.

PRA is proudly working with the Kilkivan, Widgee, Mary River, and Dagon/Amamoor Action Groups to help achieve what seems to be an impossible goal, sensible policy development that puts regional communities first.

"PRA on behalf of affected landowners have a simple message for Powerlink Queensland, Kathy Hirschfeld AM, the Chair of Powerlink and the State government, STATE LAND FIRST."

Impacted landowners can make their concerns known at a rally in Widgee, part of the Gympie region, on Friday 17 March.

"Our rural community's matter and this point seems to be evading Powerlink."

"Minister de Brenni has been invited to attend the rally and he is most welcome to make himself available to hear community concerns firsthand," Mr Atkinson said.
